Campaign Objectives

- Encourage individuals to ask questions before borrowing money, either in person or online
- Encourage people to ask awkward questions of friends and family members if they are worried they have borrowed from a loan shark
- Encourage organisations to ask questions of clients who have money worries in case they have borrowed from a loan shark
- Provide reassurance and support for those who may feel that they have no option but to turn to an illegal lender
- Raise awareness of the SIMLU helpline and website and signpost to organisations who can help

	Ask the Question: Individuals		
1	Before borrowing money from anyone, make sure to #AskTheQuestion "Will you tell me exactly how much I've borrowed and how much I need to pay back?" If the answer is no, they may be a loan shark. Find out more at www.stopillegallending.co.uk		
2	Before borrowing money from anyone, make sure to #AskTheQuestion "Will you give me paperwork and a clear repayment plan?" Loans from illegal lenders can end up costing three times as much as a legal loan Find out more at www.stopillegallending.co.uk		
3	Before responding to a social media advert or message offering a quick and easy loan, #AskTheQuestion "Can I trust that you won't add interest or extra charges without warning me?" Always check that a lender has been authorised by the FCA Find out more at www.stopillegallending.co.uk		
4	Before borrowing money online, #AskTheQuestion "Has the lender been authorised by the FCA?" If not, they may be a loan shark and you could end up paying huge amounts of interest Find out more at www.stopillegallending.co.uk		
5	If you're in a financial crisis, #AskTheQuestion "Where can I turn for confidential and non-judgemental support and advice?" Find organisations who can help at www.stopillegallending.co.uk
